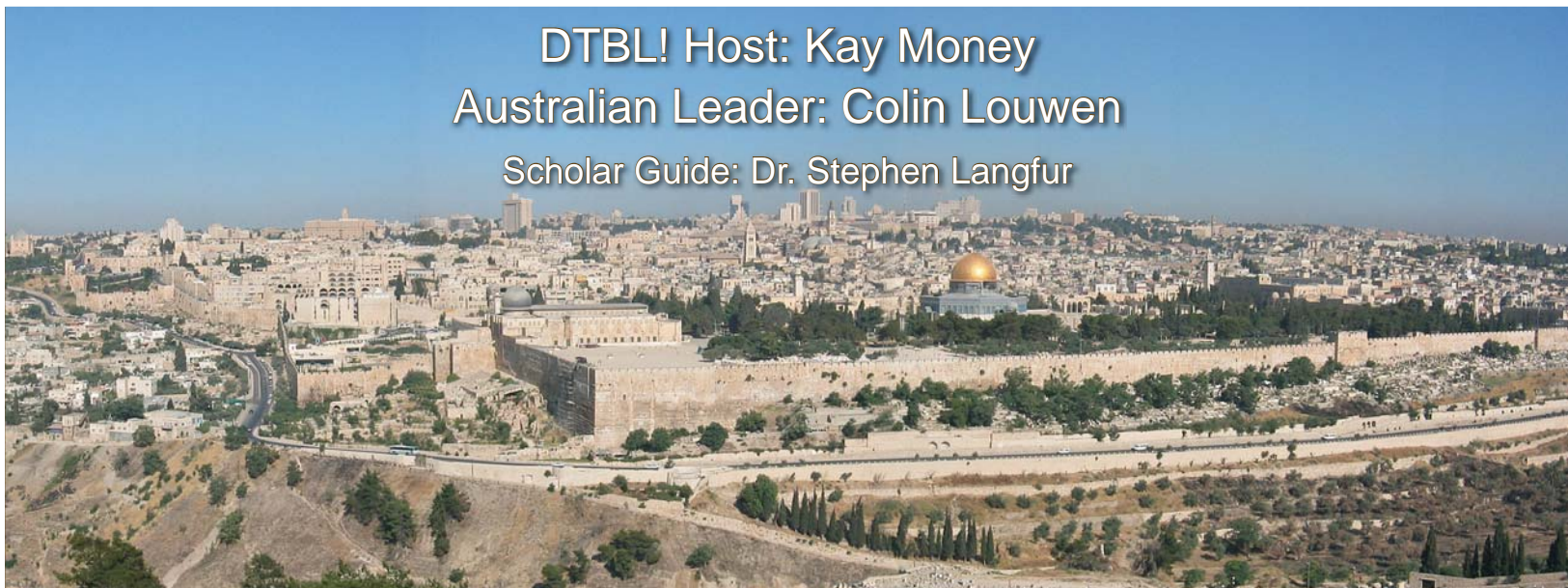

Day 1 Tues., March 27 DEPARTURE

Arrive at the **home airport** at least four hours prior to departure for your international check-in procedures. Meals and in-flight services are per airline policies.

NOTE: It is possible that the itinerary may be adjusted per discretion of the guide and tour leader.



Day 2 Wed., March 28 ARRIVE TEL AVIV

Region: Coast of Sharon

Arrive **Tel Aviv**. Proceed through passport control (keep the white entry paper in passport). Stay together through Passport Control, meet the NET representative, retrieve luggage at the baggage-claim area, then move together and meet our guide. Here we will exchange money to Israeli shekels. We will proceed to **Jaffa** (The Book of Jonah). **Lunch** there. Continue to **Netanya** for lodging. Enjoy dinner and an evening swim or a private time to stroll the beach of the **Mediterranean Sea**.

Day 3 Thu., March 29 TO SEA OF GALILEE

Region: Coast of Sharon, Jezreel Valley, Sea of Galilee



Visit **Caesarea Maritima**, including the site of the Herodian harbor, Pilate's house and the stadium. Proceed to **Muhraka** ("Burnt Offering") on **Mt. Carmel**. (1 Kings 18: Elijah and the Prophets of Baal.) **Lunch**. We cross the country to the **Arbel cliff**, which affords a magnificent view from the west over the **Sea of Galilee**. *The adventurous*

may climb down the face of the cliff with the help of cables affixed to the rock. Continue to our lovely lodging at the **Sea of Galilee**.



Day 4 Fri., March 30 SEA CIRCLE TRIP

Region: Sea of Galilee

Today centers around the **Sea of Galilee** and the sites of Jesus' ministry. Visit **Capernaum**, then the **Mt. of Beatitudes** (Matthew 5–7), followed by the black basalt town of **Chorazin**. After lunch (optional St. Peter's fish) we shall view the remains of a **fishing boat** from Jesus' day. From here we shall spend an hour on the beautiful **Sea of Galilee** in a wooden boat modeled after the one we have seen. This evening we shall have a **candlelight service** on the shore of the **Sea of Galilee**.

Day 5 Sat., March 31 MEGIDDO, NAZARETH, JEZREEL PLAIN

Region: Lower Galilee, Sea of Galilee



We shall start the day with **baptisms** in the **Jordan**. (Bring bathing suits and a solid white gown that covers shoulders and knees—not transparent when wet—or rent a gown for about \$10.) We then drive to **Megiddo**. Here we shall explore the background of the prophecy concerning **Armageddon** (the hill [Ar] of Megiddo). We continue on to **Nazareth**. After a visit in one of the town's churches, we drive up to a viewing spot, from which we see the site of the ancient village on one side and the **Jezreel Plain** and **Mt. Tabor** on the other. Return to our lodging at the Sea of Galilee. (Optional: Jewelry shopping in **Tiberias** in the evening.)

Day 6 Sun., April 1 UPPER JORDAN

(Palm Sunday)

Region: Upper Jordan, Sea of Galilee

Today we briefly visit **Hazor**, the land's largest **Canaanite city**, destroyed by Joshua and rebuilt by Solomon. We drive north to **Tel Dan**. Here we shall walk through the nature reserve at the headwaters of the **Jordan**, then visit the ruins, including the high place built at **Dan** by Jeroboam, son of Nebat (I



Kings 12), as well as a 3800-year-old triple-arched city gate. We proceed to **Caesarea Philippi**, recounting Peter's Confession (Matthew 16) at the foot of **Mt. Hermon**. We return to our lodging via the **Golan Heights**, with a view toward **Damascus**.

Day 7 Mon., April 2

BETH SHEAN, JERICHO, DEAD SEA

Region: Lower Jordan, Rift Valley

Depart to **Beth Shean** for an overview. Those who wish may climb the Tel to hear and visualize the story of Saul. Then we continue to **Jericho**, the world's oldest city. Travel beside the **Dead Sea**, 1460 feet below sea level. We continue to a hotel on the Dead Sea's southwestern shore. Here we may **float in the Dead Sea** and enjoy the **spa** facilities.



Day 8 Tue., April 3

NEGEV DESERT

Region: Negev Desert

Today we head for the stark beauty of the **Negev**. We begin with a visit to the Israelite temple on **Tel Arad**. Then we hike the beautiful **Zin Valley** to Ein Avdat. Those who wish may climb out of the wadi (ca. 500 feet), visiting the cave of a Byzantine monk on the way. We continue to the Nabataean-Byzantine city of **Avdat**. Return to our Dead Sea Hotel.



Day 9 Wed., April 4

DEAD SEA, JERUSALEM

Region: Dead Sea and Jerusalem



Ascend via cable car to visit **Masada**. Amid Herodian grandeur, we hear the story of the Jewish revolt against Rome. After lunch, we hike into the **David River** at **Ein Gedi** as far as its main waterfall. We then proceed to **Qumran** and view a cave where the **Dead Sea scrolls** were found. Finally we ascend to **Jerusalem** for an orientation to the city from the **Mount of Olives**. We descend the mountain on the traditional Palm Sunday road. Lodge in Jerusalem.

Day 10 Thu., April 5

JERUSALEM

(Maundy Thursday)

Region: Jerusalem

Getting an early start, we visit the **original Jerusalem** (*City of David*), with **Warren's shaft** and the ancient water system. Those who wish will wade through **Hezekiah's Tunnel** to the newly discovered **Pool of Siloam** (John 9:7). (Bring flashlights, bathing suits and footwear which will stay securely on the feet in the water current.) We then take in the **Bar Mitzvah ceremonies** at the Western Wall. After lunch in the Jewish Quarter, we visit a **Herodian mansion** there. We then proceed to **Yad VaShem** with the **Holocaust History Museum** (open late today). **Dinner with a special guest.**



Day 11 Fri., April 6

BETHLEHEM, JUDEAN WILDERNESS

(Good Friday. Passover Eve)

Region: Bethlehem and Judean Wilderness

We drive to **Herodion**, a mountain whose top third was built by Herod as his palace, fortress and recently discovered tomb.



Heading north-west toward **Bethlehem**, we shall stop briefly at **Solomon's Pools**. We then drive to **Shepherds' Fields** with its cave. After visiting the **Church of the Nativity**, we continue to the **Evangelical Lutheran Church Compound** to view an **ancient home-cave** thus, giving us a deeper understanding of 1CE stable in which Jesus was born. Then we take time at one of the **Bethlehem shops**, famous for olive wood, jewelry and mother-of-pearl. We shall also stop to renew ministry friendships at **Bethlehem Bible College** and **Bethlehem Hospital** (BASR). Return to Jerusalem. (We will be with another guide for this day's itinerary.)

Day 12 Sat., April 7

JERUSALEM

(First Day of Passover / 7th-14th Pesach)

Region: Jerusalem

Visit **Gethsemane**. Then walk through **Stephen's Gate** to **St. Anne's Church** and the **Pools of Bethesda**. We walk the **Via Dolorosa** to the **Church of the Holy Sepulcher**. This afternoon



we visit the **Israel Museum** with the **Shrine of the Book**. Here we shall see the **Dead Sea Scrolls** and the **outdoor model of Jerusalem** (scale 1:50) as it may have looked in 66 AD, just before the Jewish revolt against Rome. We shall also tour the new archaeological wing of the museum, which is the best in the world for finds relating to the Bible. (Museum closes at 5 pm.)

Day 13 Sun., April 8

**FREE DAY JERUSALEM
Optional SHECHEM**

(Easter Sunday / Palm Sunday Orthodox)

You may choose one of two alternatives for this day.

(Option #1)

You can take it as a free day for going to a **Church of your choice (or enjoy our private service in the Ambassador Garden)**, shopping in the **Old City**, or select other activities from many interesting places on your **Places to Go and Things to Do list**, after checking to be sure that they are open on Sunday. **Rest** is also recommended!



(Option #2) (For an additional fee and if available at the time)

After a brief Resurrection Morning service in the Ambassador Garden, we leave by 9 am. We will make a bus trip into the heartland of the First Testament. The first choices will include, in the Nablus area, the Tel of ancient **Shechem** (Joshua 24) We shall see a "standing stone" while we read Joshua's words in Joshua 24:1–28. We then go to **Jacob's Well nearby** (John 4). Other possibilities, according to time and accessibility, include the top of **Mt. Gerizim** (ancient and present-day Samaritan settlements) and **Ahab's Samaria** (which became Herod's



Sebastia). From Gerizim, we may also view **Mt. Ebal** and read the "blessings and curses" (Deut. 27–28).

We conclude the day with a **Special Group Dinner**. Also included will be the **gift exchange** with your secret prayer partner.

Day 14 Mon., April 9

JERUSALEM

Region: Jerusalem

We ascend the **Temple Mount** with the **Dome of the Rock**. We then visit the **Ophel Excavations**, including the **Temple Steps** where Jesus would have walked and taught. After lunch, we drive to the **Garden Tomb** for a private tour and communion. Return to the hotel by 4 pm to ready ourselves for early dinner and the journey home.

Day 15 Tue., April 10/11

ARRIVE HOME

Fly home while reliving the experiences of having walked and lived the **Lands of the Bible**—and our new HOME. Arrive in the USA on April 10th early in the morning at Newark International Airport and proceed through customs. Or arrive in Australia on April 12th and proceed through customs.

HOW IT ALL BEGAN...

My first visits to Israel, in the 1970s, changed my life forever! Having read the Bible many times through, I found a whole new frame-of-reference. But because those early tours were the typical touristy tours many questions remained, including, "Why that Land?" In the early 1990s I co-hosted a short one-of-a-kind scholar-guided tour. This tour specialized in strong scholarship which also focused on that very question!



The Trigger Quote: "Why that Land?" No one had ever had a good answer. Then on the first day, the scholar guide said, "History does not repeat itself without explaining itself, and the explanation is usually geographical." (George Adam Smith) I finally had a foundation with which to work—but there was something else missing in that statement—it was the "culture" aspect. Suddenly, I saw a triangle with geography as the foundation on which the culture developed with the ensuing history at the top level. True, there are other influences, invading cultures etc., but that was the basic model! The geography was foundational! Finally, I had found solid answers to many of my nearly life-long questions!

The incredible scholarship further confirmed in my mind that individual study, word studies and exegesis were all necessary study tools for proper biblical understanding and application but those tools often lacked those three keys within the frame-of-reference of the Land itself!

As we walked that Land, it was evident that people were not absorbing the experience to its fullest—they simply were not prepared for the journey. I remember voicing my lament to Dr. Russel Jones, as we walked down the Mount of Olives. His comment was "Kay, you have to do it...you have to get a group and do that [bridge the gap]." Scoffing at the notion and giving every conceivable reason why I couldn't do such a thing, I knew by the time we reached the Garden of Gethsemane that God had called me to do just that.

Discover The Bible Lands! was founded for that purpose! To prepare the seeker before the tour...to greatly enhance their discovery of the puzzle pieces that form the BIG PICTURE, thus, changing lives...and then growing numbers to minister within the proper frame-of-reference!

Tour Features and Conditions

Please read all Tour Features and Conditions carefully.
Payment of tour deposit constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

Air Transportation: Air transportation is restricted to the services of any IATAN carrier, in economy class based on nonrefundable fare. Travelers are responsible to provide their names as they appear in their passport. Ticketing will be made 30-45 days prior to departure, after which there will be a charge for name corrections. Tour price does not include current airline taxes and fuel surcharges of \$611 which are subject to change until ticketed. *Tour participants are responsible for any increase in airline taxes or fuel surcharges imposed by the airline.*

Accommodations: Based on two persons sharing a room in accommodations listed in itinerary, or similar, with private facilities, including service charges and taxes. Single rooms are subject to availability at an additional charge of \$895. *If a passenger cannot supply a roommate and Discover The Bible Lands! is unable to provide one for you, the passenger is responsible for the additional charge.*

Meals: In-flight meals and snacks are served according to airline policy. Breakfast and dinner will be provided daily. Opportunity will be given for lunches to be secured by tour members, at their own expense. Beverages with lunches and dinners are not included.

Transfers and Baggage: Transfers between airports and hotels upon arrival and departure are included in the tour price, including handling of one medium-sized suitcase per person, not exceeding 62 dimensional inches (length plus width plus height) or weighing more than a maximum of 50 pounds. *Due to limited luggage storage space on motorcoaches, it is **important** that each person bring only **ONE** piece of checked baggage. In addition, a flight bag or overnight case may be taken, which must be handled by the passenger at all times. Baggage allowance is subject to change according to airline policy.*

Sightseeing and Entrance Fees: Are included as indicated in itinerary, using private motorcoach or other conveyance, with local guides where necessary.

Tips and Taxes: Service charges and taxes on accommodations are included. Tips to guides, drivers, and hotel staff are included. Tips for personal services and lunches are not included and are at tour member's own expense.

Not Included: Airline taxes and fuel surcharges, passport fee, travel protection insurance, lunches, beverages with lunches and dinners, and expenses of a purely personal nature are not included. Transportation from your home to Cleveland International Airport and vice versa is not included.

Deposit and Payment: Reservations may be secured upon payment of a deposit of \$500 per person. You will be invoiced for final payment, which is due January 27, 2012.
